



Public Service Fellow Membership Category **American College of Trial Lawyers**

The American College of Trial Lawyers has a Public Service membership category for Fellows who are employed in government offices, educational facilities, or public service organizations.

Public Service Fellow

A Public Service Fellow is defined as one who is:

- a. Employed on a full-time basis by federal, state or local governments or agencies thereof;
- b. Employed on a full-time basis by legal aid, public defenders or public service groups; or
- c. Full-time employees of law school facilities.

Public Service Fellow Benefits

In recognition of the important work provided by Fellows in public service, the College offers several benefits to Fellows in this membership category.

Annual Dues

- Dues for Public Service Fellows are assessed at \$100 annually.

National Meeting Registration

- National Meeting registration fees are significantly reduced for Fellows and their spouse/guest.
- The black-tie banquet ticket price is also significantly reduced.

Local and Regional Meeting Registration

- A fund has been set aside by the Board of Regents to assist Public Service Fellows who wish to attend local and regional meetings. The funds available can be used towards registration fees, travel to the meeting or accommodations.
